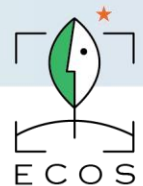
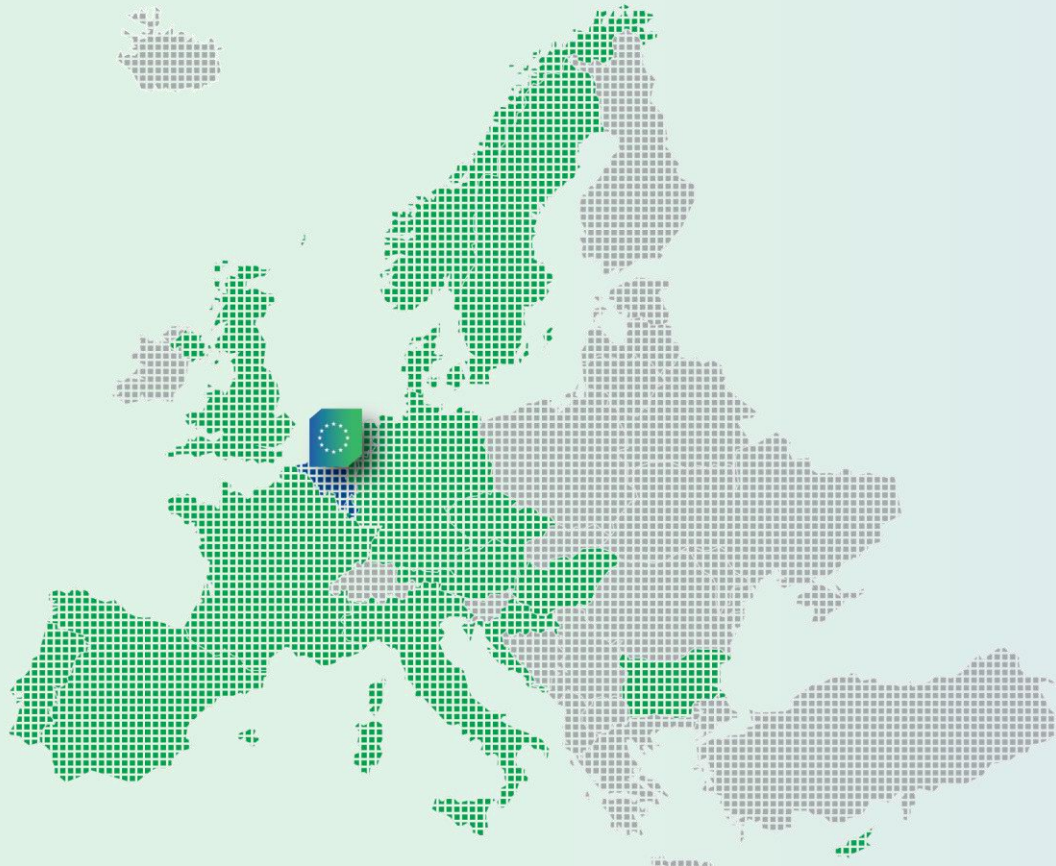

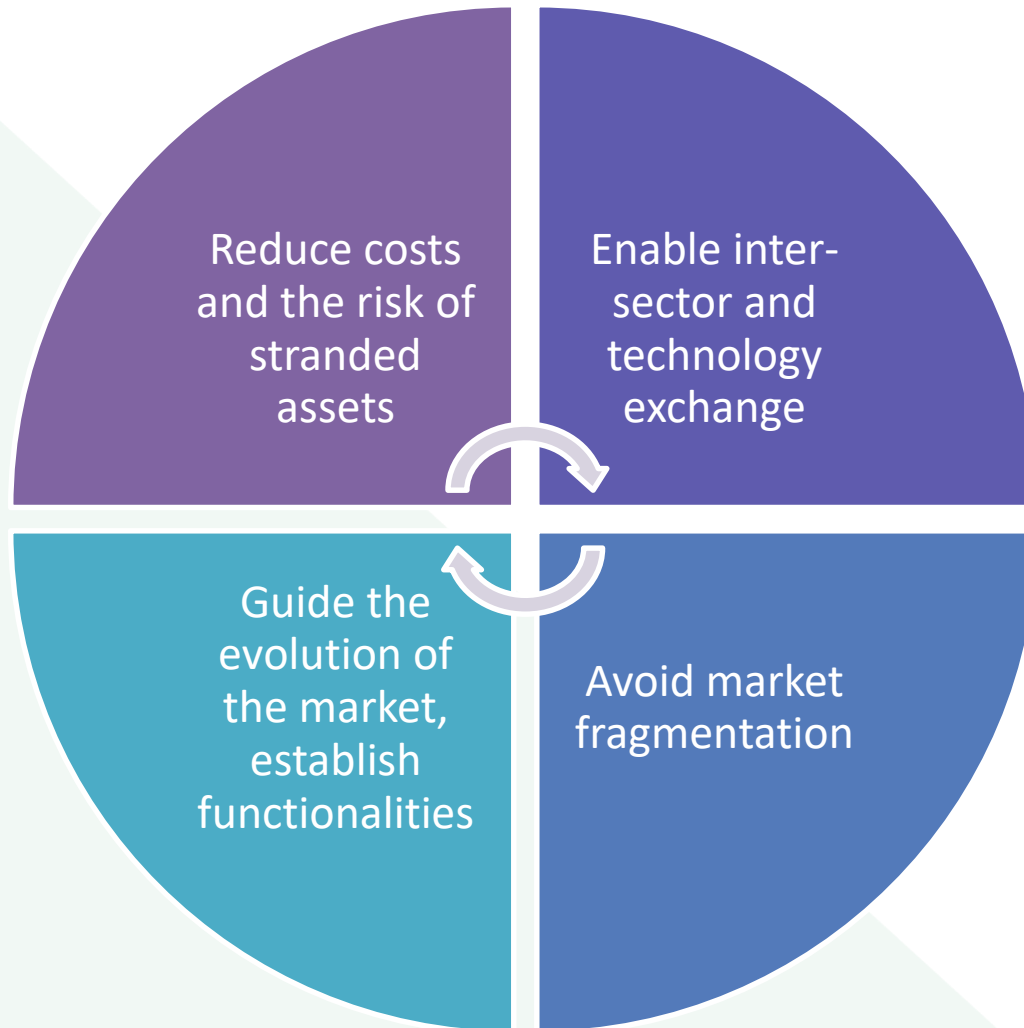


# Context

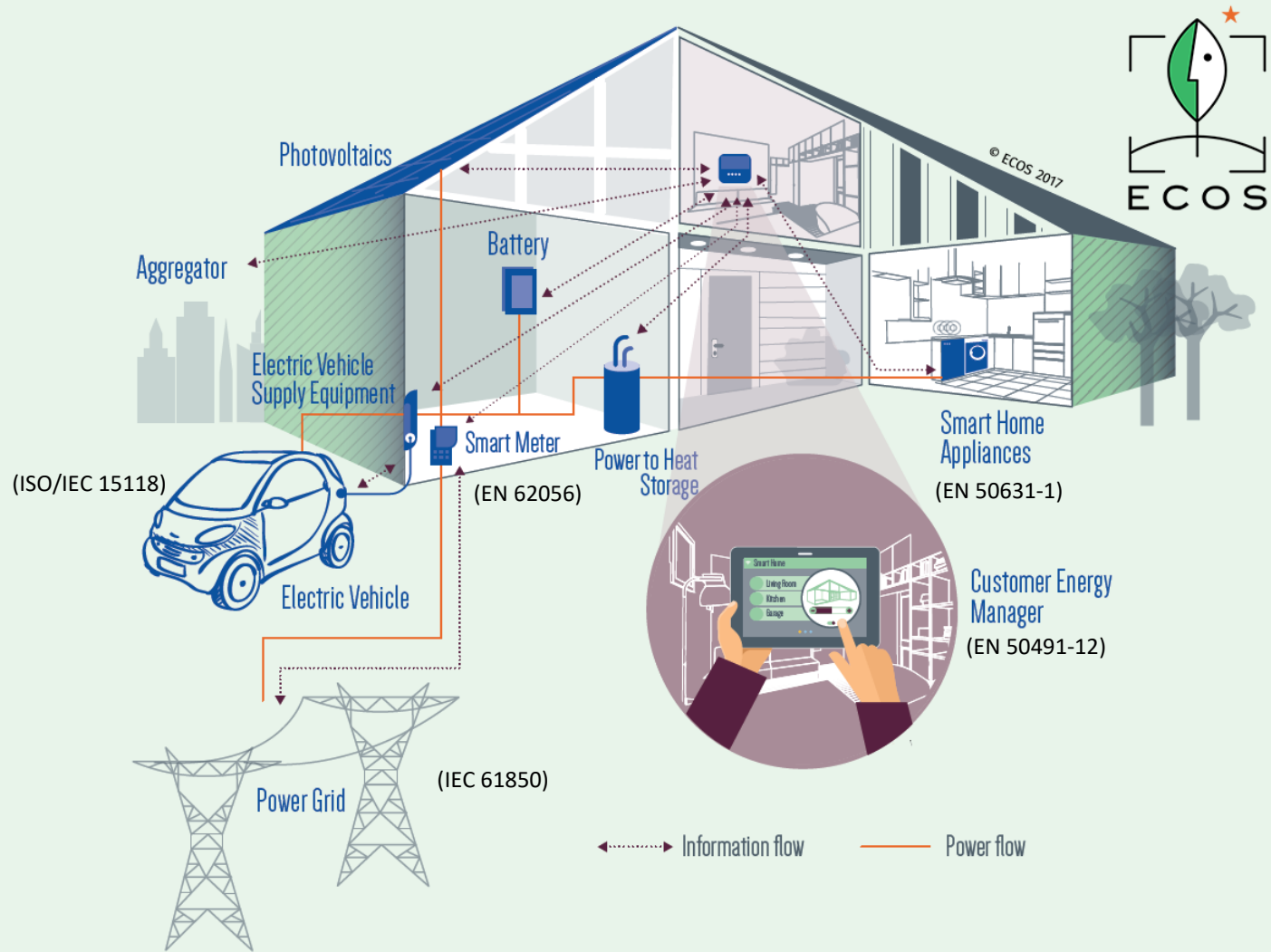
- Power sector is undergoing a period of rapid transformation

- Standards can offer a technical foundation for this transition



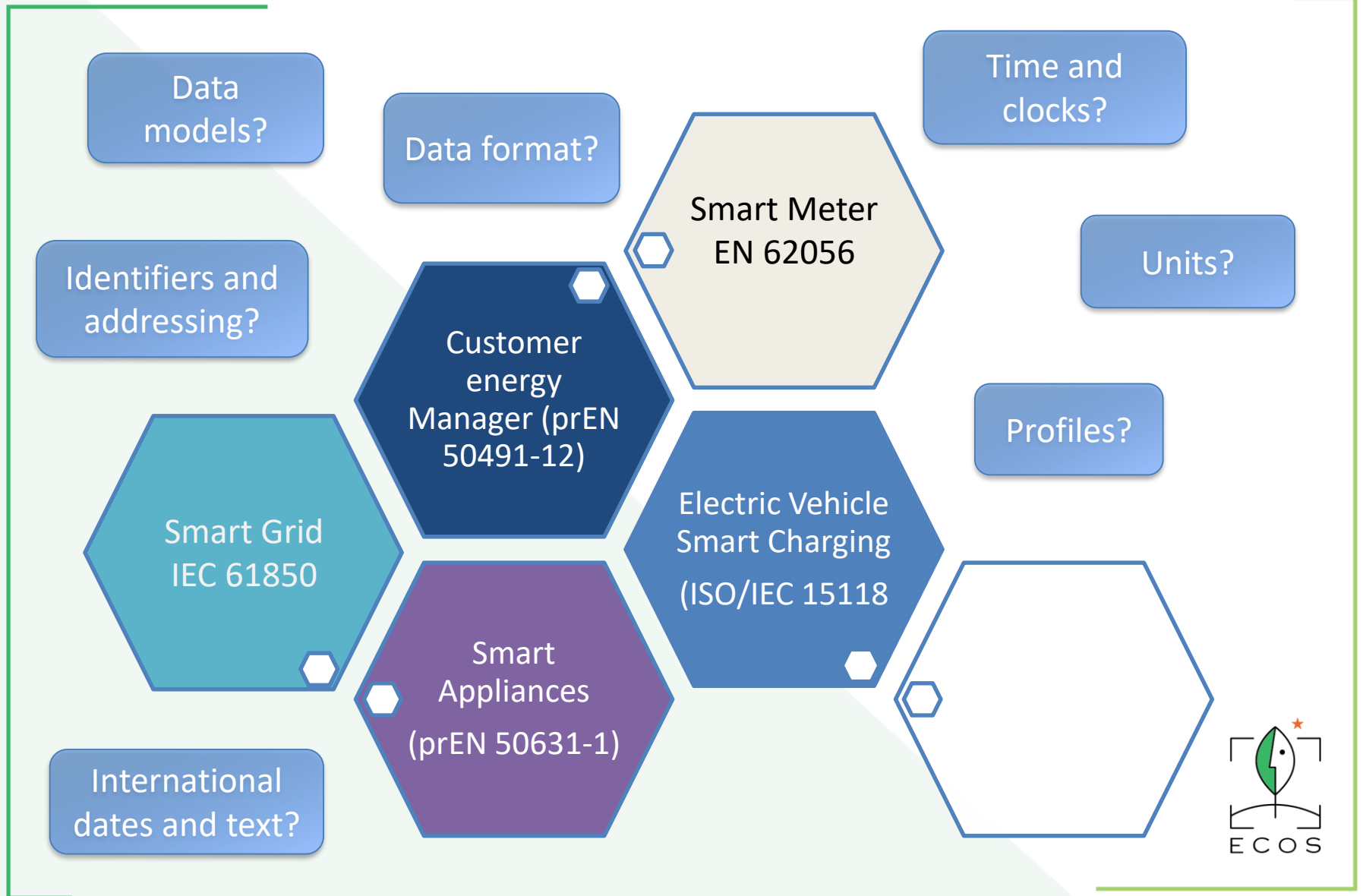

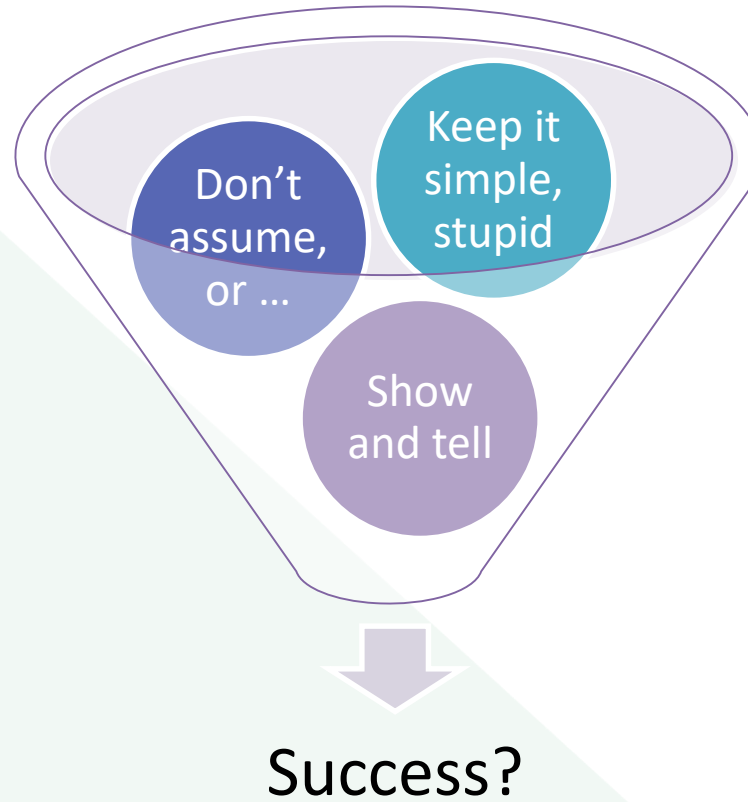

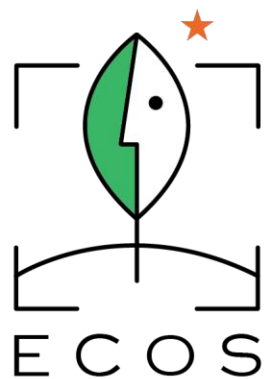
